# Why do we do it?



- Every two minutes a women dies from pregnancy or childbirth complications ...
  99% in developing countries.
- Every day, 15,000 children die from completely preventable causes such as malnutrition, pneumonia, diarrhea and malaria.
- 60% of preventable maternal deaths, 5% of deaths among children younger than five years and 45% of neonatal deaths take place in fragile settings of conflict, displacement, and natural disasters.



# Why do we do it?

- Approximately 74 million unintended pregnancies occur in developing countries every year.
- An estimated 25 million unsafe abortions happen every year.
- 200 million girls and women in 30 counties have been subjected to female genital mutilation.
- Complications during pregnancy and childbirth are the second leading cause of death for 15-19 year old girls.





  - Visits to 480+ postpartum women and babies; 1920 home visits; training 20 local Village Team Workers (VHTs) in Uganda

#### **Born on Time:**

- CanWaCH Members: World Vision; Plan International Canada; Save the Children with the Government of Canada and Johnson & Johnson
  - 5-year initiative to increase newborn survival by supporting local health systems with affordable, accessible care for mothers and premature babies



#### More and Better Midwives in Rural Tanzania:

- CanWaCH Members: Canadian Association of Midwives; Amref Health Africa in Canada
  - Building capacity for an additional 230 in-service midwives
