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NEW MATERNAL-NEONATAL COVID-19
GENERAL GUIDELINE: INFORMATION FOR
HEALTHCARE PROVIDERS



On May 30th, 2020, the Provincial Council for Maternal and Child Health (PCMCH) in collaboration with Maternal-Neonatal COVID-19 Task Force released a <u>Maternal-Neonatal COVID-19 General Guideline</u> for all perinatal and newborn care providers in Ontario.

The main topics covered in the guideline include:

- Use of PPE during labour and birth
- Support people during labour and birth
- Care of babies
- Infant testing
- NICU/SCN practices
- Monitoring/Surveillance

<u>The Ministry of Health</u> has also released a guideline, which is informed by the PCMCH Maternal-Neonatal COVID-19 General Guideline, and in addition to the topics above, presents information on how to report probable or confirmed COVID-19 cases, as well as occupational health and safety practices.

COVID-19, PERINATAL, AND NEWBORN CARE: INFORMATION FOR FAMILIES IN ONTARIO



Health Nexus and PCMCH have partnered to prepare public-facing educational information on the provincial COVID-19 guideline by:

- Co-producing webinars for the public and regional networks
- Updating existing Best Start resources with COVID-19 information
- Designing new fact sheets for families
- Engaging regional networks, the public, and maternal-newborn care practitioners via social media and a joint communication plan

New resources were developed for the public using stakeholder and expert engagement process, and focused on four areas below:

- Support persons during labour and birth
- Care for mother-baby dyad
- Care for babies in NICU
- Infant feeding

These resources are aimed to help families receive the information they need when having a baby during COVID-19.

The primary audience is individuals who will give birth in Ontario during the COVID-19 pandemic and their families/support people. Some of the information is applicable to parents in the weeks after birth as well.
